Dose Notices & Reports to Individuals

The North Carolina Radiation Protection Regulations 10A NCAC 15 are provided to you at https://radiation.ncdhhs.gov/regs.htm. Regulations 10A NCAC 15 .1004(a) and CFR 19.13(a) require notification to individuals. How this information is provided to the individual is up to the registrant, but each notification must be in written format and include the information below:

When Notification is Required:

- If an individual's occupational dose exceeds 1 mSv (100 mrem) TEDE or 1 mSv (100 mrem) to any individual organ or tissue in a year
- If an individual requests his or her annual dose report
- At the request of a former worker

Appropriate Identifying Data:

- Name of the licensee (registrant)
- Name of the individual
- The individual's social security number or unique identifier
- Include the individual's exposure information

The Notification Must Include the Following Statement:

"This report is furnished to you under the provisions of 10A NCAC 15 .1000: NOTICES: INSTRUCTIONS: REPORTS AND INSPECTIONS. You should preserve this report for future reference."

The agency accepts either the statement in 10 CFR 19.13(a) or the statement in 10A NCAC 15 .1004(a).

10 CFR 19.13(a): This report is furnished to you under the provisions of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulation 10 CFR part 19. You should preserve this report for further reference.

10A NCAC 15 .1004(a): "This report is furnished to you under the provisions of 10A NCAC 15 .1000: NOTICES: INSTRUCTIONS: REPORTS AND INSPECTIONS. You should preserve this report for future reference."

For compliance purposes the statement on the notification must be consistent with either 10 CFR 19.13(a) or 10A NCAC 15 .1004(a).

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
