LEASING INDUSTRIAL/NON-HEALING ARTS RADIATION EQUIPMENT FOR REGISTRATION

LESSOR'S REQUIREMENTS

- ♦ Must be registered with the N.C. Radiation Protection Section prior to offering to lease or provide any type of radiation-related services.
 - If not registered, must submit a "Class I Sales of Radiation Machines and a) Machine Components" application, which is available online at https://radiation.ncdhhs.gov/Xray/service.htm
 - b) Lessor is subject to annual registration fees.
- Email a notification to the N.C. Radiation Protection Section to XrayService@dhhs.nc.gov at least five days prior to shipment of leased equipment to lessee.
- Provide notification that includes the lessee's name, name of contact person, address, phone number and projected dates of lease.

(Note: Equipment used for federal projects are not subject to North Carolina Regulations)

LESSOR'S OBLIGATION TO LESSEE

- ❖ Inform the lessee of registration requirements. Lessee must submit a "Non-Healing Arts Application for Registration," which is available online at: https://radiation.ncdhhs.gov/
- Report the equipment identification to Lessee. Include manufacturer, model and serial number.
- Provide a copy of manufacturer's manual of operation and safety procedures, a copy of most recent survey and calibration reports of each unit.

LESSEE'S REQUIREMENTS

- Submit a "Non-Healing Arts" Application for Registration.
- ♦ (Note: Section 7 on application: "Serial Number" and "Install Date of Each Control" - if not known, use first day of lease date, i.e. for January 30, 2007, use 013007)

- Include a check for registration fees based on period of lease in the RPS fiscal year:
 - July 1 December 31 \$180.00 for facility and 1st unit; add \$24.00 for each additional unit; or
 - January 1 June 30 \$90.00 for facility and 1st unit; add \$8.13 for each additional unit.
- ❖ Notify the RPS if use of X-ray equipment is discontinued prior to July 1.
- Submit name(s) and documentation of training for each operator.
- Maintain records of lease, operators, safety and operating procedures, and calibration records and personnel dosimetry for review during state radiation inspections.
