REGISTRANTS MOST FREQUENT VIOLATIONS

- 1. The facility Written Radiation Protection program was not available or not adequate.
- 2. Not maintaining the appropriate records (Notice of Registration (NOR), Plan Review, Report of Assembly (FDA 2579), Letter of Acknowledgement (LOA), Post room survey, and annual review of Written Safety program).
- Personnel monitoring equipment has not been supplied and/or used by all 3. occupationally exposed personnel.
- The registrant failed to update the information contained in the application for 4. registration or notice of registration no longer accurate.
- 5. The registrant failed to annually review the Written Radiation Protection program.
- The registrant failed to have a copy of the "North Carolina Regulations For 6. Protection Against Radiation" at the facility.
- 7. The registrant failed to provide a working technique chart for each diagnostic Xray system.
- 8. There has not been an area radiation survey done within 30 days following initial operation of equipment.
- Service Provider failed to submit records showing receipt, transfer, and/or disposal 9. of radiation sources.
- 10. Annual registration fees not submitted.
